



Youth Group Activities

We offer both kits (either with or without docent support) and tours (again, with or without docent support). Currently our kits are being revised; we expect them to become available again before December, 2009.

Garden tours

A tour can be tailored to your group, focusing on the particular specialty gardens or topics you desire after consultation with Education staff or docents. Tours are tailored for any grade level and last up to one hour.

Independent tours:

Cost: \$2 per person

Size restriction: none

Schedule: minimum of 48 hours in advance

Guided tours:

Cost: \$2 per person plus \$20 guide fee

Size restriction: thirty (30) individuals, including chaperones and teachers

Schedule: minimum of 3 weeks in advance

***Butterfly Magic* tours**

Students visit the butterfly flight exhibit, seeing butterflies from nearly every tropical region of the world. They also stop outside our emergence room, which has a large window, allowing children to observe the incubating chrysalises.

Appropriate grade level: all

Time: approximately one hour on the Garden grounds, 15 minutes in the flight exhibit. Because of the heat and humidity, this is about the maximum time that a group can stay in the exhibit.

Cost: \$3 per person, which includes admission to the Gardens

Size restriction: seventy five (75) individuals, including chaperones and teachers

Time: 10 a.m. daily, typically. If another time is desired, please discuss this when making your reservation.

A pre-visit packet will be sent to you along with your confirmation letter.

Butterfly Magic plus Gardens, guided:

For an additional \$20 per 20 individuals, a docent or volunteer will lead a tour or give a presentation enhancing your group's visit to the Gardens.
