Arizona Native Plant Society and Tucson Audubon Society. *Desert Bird Gardening*, 1997. This \$2 booklet describes desert and low water use plants for attracting birds. Small color photos show both plants and birds.

Brooklyn Botanic Garden. *Bird Gardens*. Handbook #156, 1998. Describes bird garden basics as well as plant lists with practical gardening information for different regions of the U. S.

Brooklyn Botanic Garden. *Hummingbird Gardens*. Handbook #163, 2000. Includes accounts of the different hummingbirds that occur in North America; practical gardening information and plant lists for different regions of the U. S.

Cunningham, Richard L. *50 Common Birds of the Southwest*. Southwest Parks and Monuments Association, 1990. An easy reference to 50 commonly seen species in the Southwest.

Kaufman, Kenn. *Lives of North American Birds*. Houghton Mifflin Co., 1996. Complete life histories for over 600 species of birds that regularly occur in North America; information on what they eat, where they build their nests, how many eggs they lay, habitat preferences, and current conservation status.

Kaufman, Kenn. *The Kaufman Focus Guide to Birds of North America*. Houghton Mifflin Co., 2000. Bird identification made easy using digitally enhanced photographs. Includes range maps and a user-friendly pictorial table of contents.

Kaufman, Lynn Hassler. *Birds of the American Southwest*. Rio Nuevo Publishers, 2000. Color photographs and descriptions of 86 species of birds that make their homes in the diverse regions of the Southwest.

Kaufman, Lynn Hassler. *Hummingbirds of the American West*. Rio Nuevo Publishers, 2003. Color photographs and descriptions, including behavioral characteristics and habitat requirements of 18 species of hummingbirds that occur in the West. Also includes a section on gardening to attract hummingbirds.

Kaufman, Lynn Hassler. *Gambel's Quail*. Rio Nuevo Publishers, 2004. Describes the life history and other fun facts about Gambel's Quail. Colored photos galore.

Kaufman, Lynn Hassler. *Roadrunners*. Rio Nuevo Publishers, 2004. Detailed information on these popular ground-dwelling members of the cuckoo family. Lots of color action shots.

Merlin, Pinau. *A Guide to Southern Arizona Bird Nests and Eggs. Volume 1: Desert Areas*. Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum Press, 2001. Useful for identifying 54 different desert bird nests. Color illustrations of 43 bird eggs.

National Geographic Society. *A Field Guide to the Birds of North America*. Illustrations and brief descriptions of the birds of North America. Includes range maps.

Peterson, Roger Tory. *A Field Guide to Western Birds*. Houghton Mifflin Co., 1990. A classic. Descriptions and illustrations of bird species of western North America. Includes range maps.
